Emotional/Behavioral Program (ED) Sheridan Community Schools

Sheridan Community Schools' adaptive educational program supports students who exhibit social, emotional or behavioral functioning that adversely affects their success in school. Success in school is measured through each student's academic progress, social relationships, individual classroom management, self-care and vocational skills. When students are not able to maintain social relationships due to medical or environmental concerns there are programs in place that provide structure and stability for students in all school environments. The level of support provided is determined by individual needs and agreed upon by the case conference committee. The Special Education Department collaborates with families and staff members to provide supports for students, staff, and parents.
